



QUICKSCAN ONLINE DYSLEXIA QUESTIONNAIRE

Introduction

QuickScan is a long established online questionnaire designed to identify indicators of SpLD/ dyslexia. It is not a test but more like a detailed checklist – which offers a starting point to exploring individual learning differences. It reflects the way that candidates learn, their strengths and weaknesses, and focuses on improving self-awareness followed by a better understanding of how to optimise performance in the learning environment or workplace.

The reports generated also provide valuable information for all learner support personnel to alert them to any learning difficulties which may require further help and support.

QuickScan Content and Reports

QuickScan is suitable for anyone over 14 years of age with a basic level of proficiency in English. It consists of approximately 100 randomised questions requiring mostly a simple 'Yes' or 'No' response and usually takes about 10-20 minutes to complete.

On completion, the candidate receives a report which includes:

- Indications of SpLD/dyslexia
- Current Learning preferences
- The need for study skills support
- Maths / numeracy
- General language support
- Learning confidence
- Indications of difficulties with fine motor skills / dyspraxia
- Signs of visual stress

There is also an additional Tutors Report – only available to learner support personnel.

This includes a breakdown presented in percentages of underlying skills the following areas - reading, writing, spelling, sequencing, organisation and memory.

It also includes the following personal details such as:

- Previous dyslexia assessment result
- Right or left-handedness
- Left/right awareness and laterality
- Hand/eye co-ordination
- Fluency in English
- Percentage scores for reading, writing, spelling, sequencing, organization and memory

QuickScan is easy to set up with no local installation and can be customised via the Settings Page (specific customization for an organisation is also available on request). Data for all QuickScan sessions can easily be downloaded for import into most management information systems.
